

Electronics Locker Key Agreement



This local agreement is entered into pursuant to Article 12, Section 16 of the Master Agreement between Passport Services and the National Federation of Federal Employees Local 1998, dated July 20, 2009. This agreement covers the current three banks of cell phone lockers intended for use by Technical Operations, Record Services (TO/RS) employees.

Further, this agreement does not cover the larger "laptop" lockers that are in the process of being ordered. This agreement does not alter any provisions or meaning of the Parties' Master Agreement (including Article 6, section 27), the December, 2016 Cell Phone Agreement and the February, 2017 Sign-in agreement (all negotiated at the nationwide level).


1. TO/RS BUEs will select a locker based on their seniority in the T.O. office as a government employee. This selection will take place within 30 days of the signing of this agreement, and at a point when the lockers have a full set of keys to be issued. Employees will not be forced to take a key if they do not want one. The selection of a locker does not affect an employee's right to also use a clear phone container.
2. Each TO/RS bargaining unit employee will be issued the key corresponding to the locker they select.
3. BUE are free to take the key home with them, but the key should not be left in the locker.
4. If the key becomes lost, the Agency will replace it at Agency expense; the Agency will only shoulder this expense once per year for any given TO/RS BUE. If an employee loses a key, they will have to sign-out a key daily, until management can get another copy of their locker key made for them. Management maintains a duplicate key, which would be used to retrieve any items locked in lockers and then un-retrievable due to the loss of the key; however, Management will maintain possession of the duplicate keys.
